

CREDIT FLEXIBILITY

DESIGN YOUR OWN LEARNING EXPERIENCE!

Earn high school credit through Credit Flexibility. Apply to use alternative ways to meet your graduation requirements. Credit Flexibility is an opportunity for students to create a significant educational learning experience in place of traditional course work.

Credit Flex may be appropriate for, but not limited to, students who:

- Want to accelerate their own learning.
- Need to recover credits for graduation.
- Want to pursue non-traditional learning situations.
- Would like to pursue their own interests and receive elective credit for doing so.

There are two options for students seeking Credit Flexibility:

- 1) Individual Proposal – Develop an individual proposal to demonstrate course proficiency.
- 2) Credit by Examination and Demonstration – Take an examination and complete additional requirements. Options vary by course.

The next application deadline is December 1, 2011.
